Dear Resident:

Various septage hauling contractors will be actively in service in the area of the H.L. Mooney Advanced Water Reclamation Facility (AWRF) beginning Monday, July 8, and ending Friday, July 12.

This brief change is due to construction taking place at the Upper Occoquan Service Authority (UOSA) Regional Water Reclamation Plant, which will temporarily prevent the facility from accepting and treating waste from septic tanks. As a result, Mooney AWRF will be accepting septage from UOSA's service areas that lie within Prince William County during this weeklong period.

As someone who lives in the area near H.L. Mooney AWRF, you could experience the following in this time:

- An increased number of vehicles/traffic bringing sludge to the plant via Rippon Boulevard (see map below for affected areas);
- An intermittent odor from the sludge being transported into the plant.

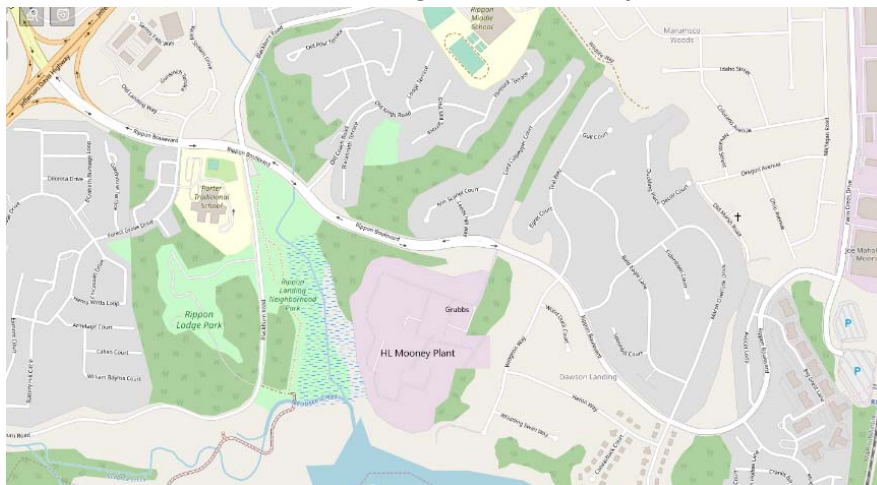

Esta carta sirve para notificarle que varios contratistas estarán activos en servicio a partir del 8 de julio y a partir del 12 de julio. Como miembro de nuestra Comunidad, usted podría experimentar:

- Un aumento en tráfico vehicular dado al incremento de camiones transportando lodos de fosas sépticas vía Rippon Boulevard hacia la Planta de Reclamación de Agua Avanzada de H.L. Mooney. (refiérase al mapa).
- Un fuerte olor proveniente de los camiones que transportan lodos de fosas sépticas.
